Info on Framework Programme 7 (FP7)



- FP7 officially launched in February 2007
 - duration 7 years until 2012
- No design studies anymore
 - would have been the natural continuation of EUDET...
- But Integrated Infrastructure Initiatives (I3) will continue
 - similar in structure, details differ
 - looks like that we should go for that
- Planned I3 calls (deadlines for submission):
 - **■** Feb. 2008: expected volume 276.5 M€
 - Feb. 2010: similar volume
 - 2012: much smaller volume, to bridge projects to FP8
 - total volume for I3s in FP7: 580 M€
 - experience from FP6: later calls might be cancelled

JM's Conclusions



• If we wish to continue we should to prepare a proposal for

February 15, 2008

even though 2nd call in Feb. 2010 will probably have less competition

- NB: I strongly believe that we must continue in the interest of the ILC!
- Good projects providing good new proposal have good chances to continue in FP7
- But be aware:

Limited amount of money to be expected

- increased overheads
 - only full cost model, flat rate of 60% overhead possible
 - 1000 € EC support would split into
 625 € eligible costs + 375 € overheads
- Total I3 budget is not much increased wrt FP6
 - number of I3 projects will probably be larger or at least similar to FP6 continue good FP6 projects
 - other aspects should be in the focus:
 - structuring the efforts
 - positive impact at other, national funding agencies

More Info on FP7 I3



Information & discussions at I3-NET Meeting in Brussels (July 18th):

- Timing for EUDET:
 - application Feb. 2008 with start end of 2009 would be appropriate
- Expected project duration and volume
 - duration 4 years
 - approx. 20 contractors (partners)
 - 4 6 M€ contribution from Brussels
 - in exceptional cases (large number of partners, large communities)
 10 − 15 M€ conceivable
- Project orientation similar to FP6
 - INFRASTRUCTURE
 - include JRAs, Networking and Transnational Access btw: other FP6 I3s do have 60% of the budget in TA!

How to Conceive an FP7 I3



JM sees two options:

A) EUDET-2:

follow-up of EUDET with essentially the same community and targets

- We need to come up with good, new infrastructure ideas targeted for the ILC detectors
 - simply not sufficient to propose the same things as in EUDET
 - just larger pixel, magnet, TPC, calo, etc.
 - must come up with something new & original
- Collect ideas now!
- Start of a list:
 - Industrialization: in line with ILC demands, could involve companies
 - DAQ: was a step child in EUDET proposal
 - Networking (ideas stolen from other I3s):
 - outreach
 - young researchers, equal opportunity
 - Strenghten Transnational Access including CERN testbeam

How to Conceive an FP7 I3



- B) Incorporate other European detector R&D projects e.g. sLHC, neutrino into a large I3
- Several obvious advantages
 - avoids competition
 - mitigates the problem of distinguishing new from existing EUDET
 - would incorporate all European detector efforts (was probably one of the strongest points of EUDET wrt ILC detector R&D)
 - many scientific synergies (infrastructure!) conceivable
- Would be a large project with 40 50 partners meaningful only with budget of ≥ 15 M€
- Discussion took place at RECFA meeting in Manchester
 - strong encouragement for coordination
 - RECFA is setting up a European Coordination Group for detector R&D planing in FP7 (à la ESGARD) with representatives from EUDET, CMS, ATLAS, neutrinos, flavour, CERN, DESY Meeting in September
 - plus reference group with national representatives

How to Proceed



- We need to discuss
 - which option A/B we want to go
 - a layout for an FP7 proposal (ILC related) independent of A/B
 - input from everyone is needed asap
 - if B proposal for common activities & synergy arguments starting today until Paris

In Paris

- finalize the proposal layout
 - item also for parallel sessions
- set up an editorial board
- discussion will be foreseen in IB meeting and last plenary session

• Keep in mind:

- proposal deadline coincides with Annual Report deadline
- probably some people will be involved in both

RECFA schedule/plans (proposal):

- 1st meeting coordination group in September (survey, initial discussion)
- need to talk to EU people to evaluate prospects (October)
- November: outline proposal(s)
