Transition from RDR to EDR

- A Full Investigation of a Cut and Cover Design Solution is Still Needed and will to be Completed in the Near Future
- Other Types of Shallow Construction Methods will be Investigated as well
- Iteration and Refinement of Design Criteria for Both Area and Technical Systems will Continue and Form the Basis for the CFS EDR Design and Value Engineering Effort
- While the Points of Contact with Area/Technical Systems were very Effective Through the RDR Development, a More Directed Process of Specific Internal and External CFS Reviews will be Utilized to Complete the Technical Criteria for the EDR



CFS EDR Planning (1)

- The Issue of Site Selection Does Complicate the CFS EDR Planning Process
- Without a Selected Site, the EDR will Need to Proceed Using Three Sample Sites
- Awareness of Additionally Identified Candidate Sites will Also be a Part of the Site Selection Process
- The EDR Effort and the Site Selection Process will Necessarily Need to Proceed in Parallel
- A Review of All Regional Requirements for Project Planning was Completed in the CFS Parallel Sessions







CFS EDR Planning (2)

- Regional Requirements Uniformly Indicate that it will be Difficult to Achieve the Stated Goal of a Site Selection in 2010 and an Start of Construction in 2012
- Progress on EDR and the Site Selection Effort will be Dependent on the Resources Provided in Each Region
- The Issue of System Integration will be an Important Part of the EDR Development and will Require Coordination Between Many of the Area/Technical and Global Systems

CFS EDR Planning (3)

- A Preliminary WBS for CFS Work Packages has been Discussed and will be Fully Developed by the CFS Group
- Each Area System and Technical System will have a Specific WBS Heading
- Additional WBS Headings will be Identified for Specific CFS Issues
- Each Work Package will Identify a Scope, Requirement for Completion, Proposed Completion Date and Responsible CFS Person
