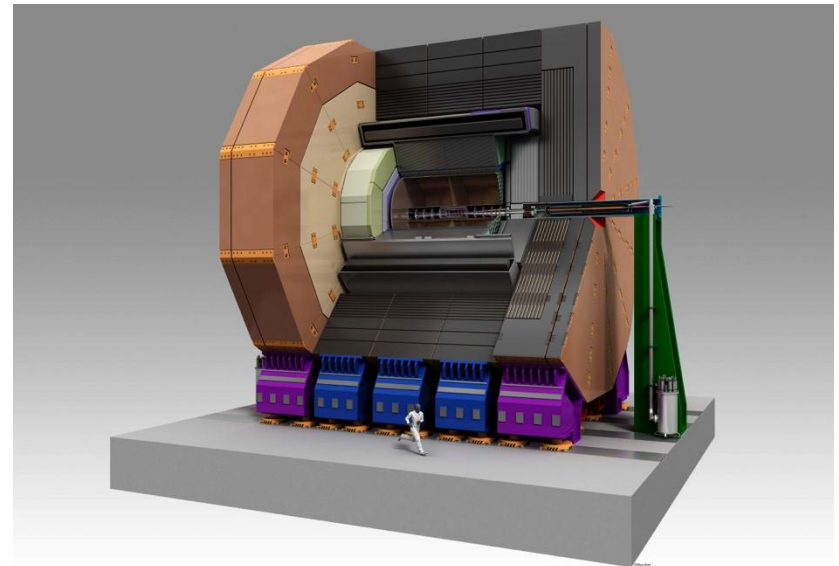
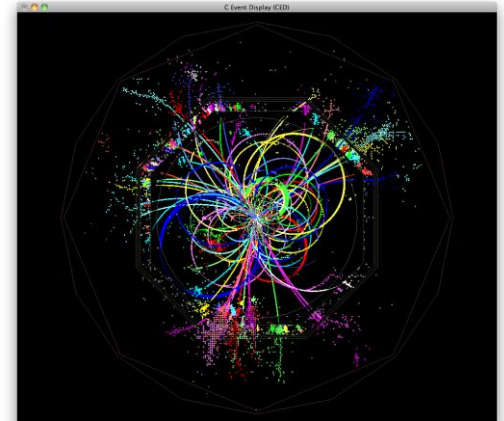


History

- FJPPL (TYL) since 2007
 - A common R&D on the new generation detector for the ILC
- CNRS-JSPS bilateral program 2011-2012
 - Electromagnetic Calorimetry for a linear collider
 - Submitted a new proposal for 2013-2014
- Collaboration agreement between CNRS/IN2P3 and Kyushu University on
 - The development of silicon sensors for an electromagnetic calorimeter

CALICE and ILD

- 2007: Japanese calorimeter team joined CALICE, where French team have been playing a main role from its beginning.
- 2008: Two detector concepts for ILC (LDC and GLD) were merged to make a new concept “ILD”.
